3. Junior Warranty. (Pedigree classes only).
4. Obedience Certificate. (Obedience classes only).

**CLASS 22 – Might Do It – JUDGE: Karen Russell**

HANDLER OR DOG who have never won a first in obedience at any show (Companion to Championship) or placed in an Open or Championship obedience show

All on lead –

\*Heelwork,

\*Novice Recall, no finish.

\*One stay exercise, handler’s choice of position. 30 seconds.

**CLASS 23 – Should Do It – JUDGE: Val Whitehead**

HANDLERS AND DOGS who are still eligible for Novice at an Open Obedience Show

\*Heelwork on lead

\*Heel Free

\*Novice Recall, with finish.

\*Retrieve handlers article with finish.

\*1 minute sit stay, 1 minute down stay

**CLASS 24 – Can Do It – JUDGE: Chris Plant**

Open to all

\*Heel free with change of paces from halts – extra commands allowed

\*Retrieve dumbbell, no extra commands.

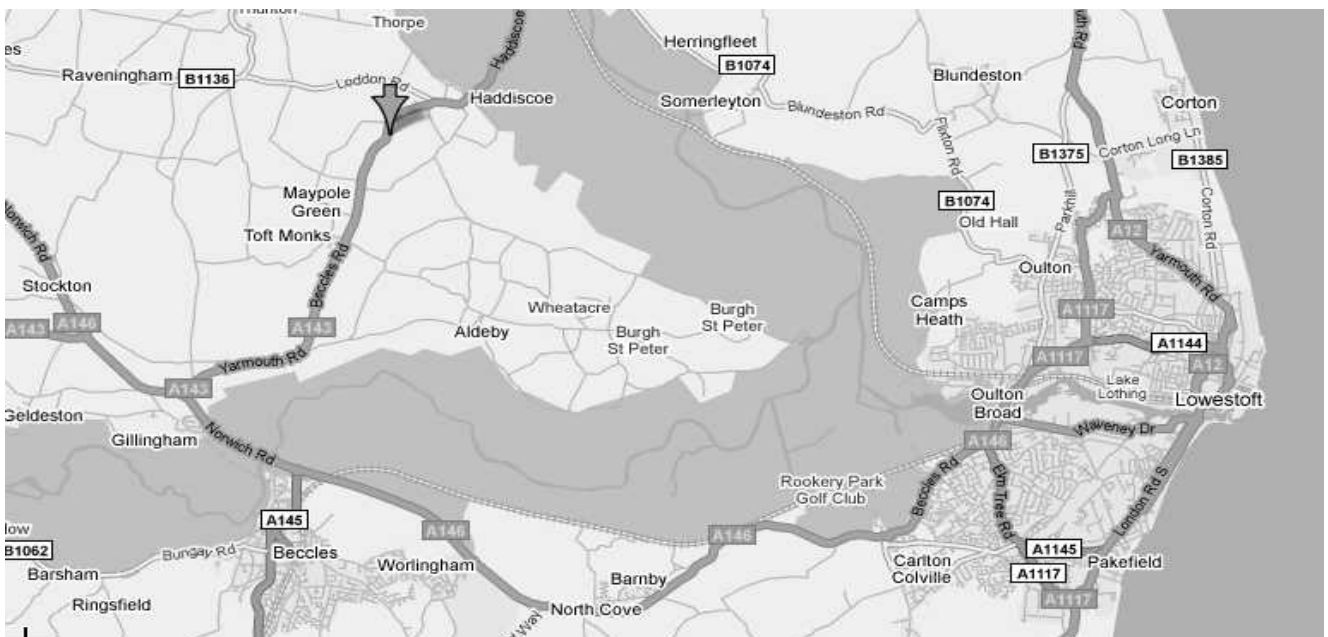
\*Sendaway and recall, no extra commands

\*1 minute sit stay, 3 minute down stay out of sight.

Please note:-

1. The judge’s decision is final. Please be sure to enter your dog in appropriate classes, if you are unsure please ask
2. Bitches in season are not welcome as it is unfair to the boys
3. Puppies under 6 months of age are not eligible for entry.
4. Dogs must be kept on leads except when under test in Obedience classes and under control at all times.
5. Obedience:-
  - In all classes, dogs may play, including with the lead, in-between exercises.
  - Food and/or toys must not be carried in the ring whilst competing.
  - Stays will take place in the ring immediately after lunch at 2pm as follows:
    - Might Do It then Should Do It then Can Do It
    - Ring-work will not restart after lunch until all the stay exercises have been completed so that that all the judges and stewards are available to steward the stays.
